Corrigendum to para 5.0 and 5.2 of the detailed CEN 01/2024

To give relief to many candidates who may have become over-aged and have missed the opportunity to appear in recruitment in Railways due to Covid pandemic, it has been decided to provide age relaxation of three (3) years over and above the prescribed upper age limit mentioned in the notification for recruitment to the post of Assistant Loco Pilot published under CEN 01/2024 as a one-time measure.

Accordingly, the paras 5.0 and 5.2 of the detailed CEN 01/2024 have been revised as under:

- 5.0 **Age Limit (as on 01.07.2024)**: 18-33 years.
- 5.2 **Date of birth** of candidates should be between the dates given below: (Both dates inclusive)

- i) If a candidate is eligible for age relaxation on more than one ground, he/she will get the maximum amongst the relaxations for which he/she is eligible (not cumulative).
- ii) SC, ST & OBC (NCL) candidates applying against UR vacancies will not get any age relaxation.
- iii) Age relaxation to ExSM candidates will be as given in para 5.1 above.

All other terms and conditions of the detailed CEN 01/2024 remain unchanged.

NOTE: Candidates with relaxed age can submit applications from 31.01.2024 12:00 PM onwards
